JENNY GAND | CV - Director's Biography:



Jenny Gand is a Vienna-based director who was born in East-Berlin in 1978. After graduating in German literature, philosophy and art history in Cologne, she moved to Vienna in 2006 and worked as assistant director at the famous Burgtheatre. During her studies, an interest in the concepts of home/ heimat, identity, memory/ remembrance and space arises in the fields of culture and media studies and philosophy.

In 2008 Jenny Gand applied at **Hamburg Media School** (HMS) for a 2-year-Master in film directing. Although accepted out of 600 applicants she decided instead to enrol with Danube University Krems for a **Master in film- & TV production**. She is working in the film industry since 1998 and gained experiences in different fields: at a TV-Station (WDR), at filmproductions (Regina Ziegler, UFA, Endemol) as well as

in theatre (Schauspielhaus Bochum, Ruhrtriennale). After three short films and two theatre plays Jenny Gand started working as a director with her first feature film in 2008, the documentary <u>Wild Mint</u> (Wilde Minze, 2009). The film had its theatrical release in Austria in 2010. Between 2010-14 she worked on many different projects such as an animation series for kids, commercials and fashion videos and took part in the mentoring program of FC Gloria for young female film makers with Sudabeh Mortezai as her mentor in 2013. In 2014 <u>Snowdrop</u> (Schneeglöckchen), her 4th short film had its international premiere in the competition of the 35th Film Festival Max Ophüls Preis and it set path for her first feature film "ZwischenZeit" (former "Mauerland") on an Eastern-western topic which is currently in script development stage and which was part of the "Diverse stories" programm in an earlier stage in 2014.

Jenny Gand is member of the <u>Austrian Directors' Association (ADA)</u> for which she had been a board member for 10 years and co-chairwoman for 5 years. She is also member of the <u>drehbuchFORUM Wien</u> (Screenwriters Forum Vienna) & member of <u>FC Gloria</u>, a network for women in the film industry. She attended as a jury member at the LET'S CEE Film Festival 2018 in the promising debuts section and at duff-Dubrovnik Film Festival 2018. For 10 years Jenny Gand is giving film workshops for kids and youngsters in Germany, Austria and Croatia. She lives and works in Vienna and has got a 3-year-old daughter with her life partner.

Directors Statement

"My films are often told in a subtle way, the image needs time and space to be revealed as well as the characters in the story. I am often dealing with the subject of memory, searching for traces of time and finding a beauty and magic in it. For me It's about letting the story and characters develop out of their inner quest and their personal environment."
